## 2009 WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY VOLLEYBALL CAMP SESSIONS

**Bruin** Entering grades 6-8 June 22-26 9am-4pm Monday-Friday Cost \$225  
(Friday's session ends at noon)

Emphasis on skill instruction and refinement, team concepts, and match play. Great camp for players of all ability levels who want to play competitive volleyball. **Fee includes a camp shirt and a BEARS camp volleyball.** Participants are reminded to bring a lunch on camp days. **We anticipate this camp will fill quickly.**

**Grizzly** Entering grades 9-12 June 29-July 3 9am-4pm Monday-Friday Cost \$225  
(Friday's session ends at noon)

Emphasis on advanced skills, concepts, strategy, and team play. Players will receive training appropriate to skill level, beginner to advanced. Great camp for players who intend to try out for their high school teams in the Fall. **Fee includes 2 camp shirts.** Participants are reminded to bring a lunch on camp days.

**Team Camp I** High School Teams June 22-24 6:30pm-9:30pm Monday-Wednesday Cost \$80/player

Tenth annual team camp. Three nights of instruction, drilling, and competition for your TEAM!! Emphasis on concepts, strategy, skill refinement, positional training, play, and team-building activities. Camp also features a coaching clinic each evening for coaches who accompany their teams. **ONE OF OUR MOST POPULAR CAMPS!! Teams may register up to 12 players for the camp. A minimum of 8 players must register to reserve a spot. All 8 forms must be sent in one envelope.** Additional registrations may be sent later. Limited to 14 teams. **Hitter** June 21 9am-4:30pm Sunday Cost \$85
