

2012 Gateway Region Scorekeeper Training Mock Sets

Explanation of Scorekeeping Example

Non-deciding Set

This is the 2012 Gold/Silver Regional Championships in St. Louis, MO. The match is being played at Oakville High School on court 16. This is pool B12a, match number 4 for junior boys at the 12's level. The date is April 30, 2012, and the match is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. This is set 1 in the match with Blue playing Red. Joe Como is the 1st referee, Marty Party is the 2nd referee, you are the scorekeeper, and Green from the Gateway Region is your work team. *The scorekeeper records all heading information using CAPITAL LETTERS and ink.*

Red won the coin toss and chose to serve. Blue chose the court to the right of the scorekeeper. The lineup for Red is 10, 17, 5c, 1, 14, 21 & 3 as the libero. The lineup for Blue is 8, 20, 13, 6, 12, 18c & 2 as the libero. *The scorekeeper enters the team names (all CAPS and in ink) and player numbers on the appropriate sides of the score sheet for set 1. The scorekeeper then places an X over the encircled S and R for the respective teams, and places an X in SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position I player of the receiving team. The scorekeeper can also fill in the team names, mark the S or R for each team, and place an X in the SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position I player of the receiving team for set 2.*

Set 1 begins at 11:03 a.m. *Fill in the START block with 11:03 a.m.*

Red #10 serves the ball into the net. *You may begin using pencil starting now. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #10, write the exit score of 0, slash point 1 in the POINTS column of the Blue team.*

Blue #20 serves two points and then a sideout. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #20, slash points 2 & 3 in the POINTS column of the BLUE team, write the exit score of 3, slash point 1 in the POINTS column of the Red team.*

Red requests a substitution, #9 for #17. Red #9 serves and the team earns a point. Red #9 scores three more points before the Blue team wins a rally. *Slash the number 17 in the box in Red's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 9 to the immediate right of the slashed number 17. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position II, record the score with Red's score listed first (1/3). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #9, slash points 2, 3, 4 & 5 in the POINTS column of the Red team, write the exit score of 5, slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Blue team.*

Blue #13 serves the ball out of bounds. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #13, write the exit score of 4, slash point 6 in the POINTS column of the Red team.*

Red #5 serves. During the rally a ball from another court rolls in front of Blue #6 as she's playing the ball. The referees stop the rally and issue a replay. On Red #5's next serve Blue wins the point. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #5. No notation is made for the replay. Write the exit score of 6 and slash point 5 in the POINTS column of the Blue team.*

Blue #12 serves. *This is a wrong server. The scorekeeper should know the wrong server is going to serve, but must wait until the illegal service actually occurs. As soon as #12 contacts the ball for service, the scorekeeper notifies the second referee of a wrong server. No tick mark is made in the SERVICE ROUNDS box (of the correct or incorrect server). The exit score of 5 is recorded in the 1st SERVICE ROUNDS box of the player who should have served (#6). Slash point 7 in the POINTS column of the Red team.*

Red #1 serves three points. Blue coach sends a sub into the substitution zone, #4 for #6. Red #1 serves two more points and then into the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #1. Slash points 8, 9 & 10. Slash the number 6 in the box if Blue's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 4 to the immediate right of the slashed number 6. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position IV (still on Blue's side of the scoresheet), record the score with Blue's score listed first (5/10). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section, is slashed. Slash points 11 & 12 in the POINTS column of the Red team, write the exit score of 12, slash point 6 in the POINTS column of the Blue team.*

Blue #12 serves four points. Red coach requests a time-out. After the time-out, Blue #12 serves again, and the Red team wins the rally. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #12. Slash points 7, 8, 9 & 10. Record the time-out in*

Red's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column, first listing Red's cumulative score followed by Blue's cumulative score (recorded 12:10). Write the exit score of 10, slash point 13 in the POINTS column of the Red team.

Red #17 enters the substitution zone and subs in for #9. Red #14 serves and the team wins the next two rallies. Blue coach requests a time-out. Red #14 serves another point. The Blue team wins the next rally. *Slash the number 9 in the box in Red's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 17 to the immediate right or underneath the slashed number 9. In the second box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position II, directly beneath the previous score at change, record the score with Red's score listed first (13/10). Team SUBSTITUTION 2, under the scoring section, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #14, slash points 14 & 15 in the POINTS column of the Red team. Record the time-out in Blue's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column, first listing Blue's cumulative score followed by Red's cumulative score (recorded 10:15). Slash point 16. Write the exit score of 16, slash point 11 in the POINTS column of the Blue team.*

The Blue captain serves a point and then into the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #18, write the exit score of 12, slash point 17 in the POINTS column of the Red team.*

Red #21 rotates to serve. After the referee whistles for serve, but before Red #21 serves, the Blue coach calls for a time-out. The referees wave off/ignore this request and Red #21 serves the ball out of bounds. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #21, write the exit score of 17, slash point 13 in the POINTS column of the Blue team. The time-out request after the service beckon is an improper request. The IMPROPER REQUEST box is located between the SANCTIONS BOX and REMARKS column. Put an X over the circled B to indicate Team B's improper request.*

Blue sends two players to the sub zone, #6 for #4, and #11 for #8. Blue #11 serves one point. During the next rally Blue hits the ball out of bounds and Red wins the point. *Slash the number 4 in the box in Blue's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 6 to the immediate right of the slashed number 4. In the second box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position IV, directly beneath the previous score at change, record the score with Blue's score listed first (13/17). Slash team SUBSTITUTION 2 under the scoring section. Now record the second sub. Slash the number 8 and write the substitute number 11 to the immediate right of the slashed 8. Record in the first box in SCORE AT CHANGE section 13/17. Slash team SUBSTITUTION 3. Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #11. Slash point 14 for Blue, write the exit score of 14, slash point 18 for Red.*

Red #10 serves an ace. Red wins the next two rallies on blocks. Blue coach requests the second time-out. After the time-out Red again scores by blocking. Blue gets a kill to win the next rally. *Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box (directly below box 1) for Red #10. Slash points 19, 20 & 21. Record the time-out in Blue's bottom TIME OUTS box, directly beneath the score of Blue's first time-out (recorded 14:21). Slash point 22 for Red. Write the exit score of 22, slash point 15 for Blue.*

Blue #20 serves three points before Red wins a rally. *Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Blue #20. Slash points 16, 17 & 18. Write the exit score of 18, slash point 23 for Red.*

Red #9 subs for #17. Red #9 serves and the team wins the next two rallies to end set 1. *Slash the number 17 in the box in Red's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 9 to the immediate right of the slashed number 17. In the third box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position II, directly beneath the previous score at change, record the score with Red's score listed first (23/18). Slash team SUBSTITUTION 3 under the scoring section. Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Red #9. Slash points 24 & 25. Write the exit score of 25.*

The time is 11:25. *Put down the pencil and use ink to complete the scoresheet. Record in all caps the WINNING TEAM and score and LOSING TEAM and score in the RESULTS box for SET 1 (Red 25 Blue 18). Put the time, 11:25, in the END box for set 1. Hourglass the unused points in the POINTS column for each team. Circle the last SERVICE ROUNDS boxes (exit scores) for each team. Check the scoresheet over. Since we used the scoresheet with sets 1 & 2 on the same page, you do not sign until the end of set 2. For Gateway competition the R1 and team captain signatures are not required.*

Explanation of Scorekeeping Example

Non-deciding Set with Libero serving

The tournament is the 2012 Gateway Girl's Festival in Belleville, IL. The match is being played at Central Jr. High on court 23. This is pool C7, match number 8 for junior girls at the 17's level. The date is February 12, 2012, and the match is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. This is set 1 in the match with Orange playing Purple. Teri Kerry is the 1st referee, Kent Tent is the 2nd referee, you are the scorekeeper, and Silver from the Gateway Region is your work team. *The scorekeeper records all heading information using CAPITAL LETTERS and ink. Time is recorded in International time (HH:MM).*

Purple won the coin toss and chose to receive. Orange will serve from the court to the right of the scorekeeper. The lineup for Purple is 7, 18c, 13, 6, 4, & 33. The Acting Libero (L) is 17 and the Reserve Libero (R) is 3. The lineup for Orange is 9, 15, 22, 19, 3c, & 5. The Acting Libero (L) is 1 and the Reserve Libero (R) is 21. After the line-up checks, Purple Libero #17 enters for #7; Orange Libero #1 enters for #5. *The scorekeeper enters the team names (all CAPS and in ink) and player numbers on the appropriate sides of the score sheet for set 1. The scorekeeper then places an X over the encircled S and R for the respective teams, and places an X in SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position I player of the receiving team. The scorekeeper can also fill in the team names, mark the S or R for each team, and place an X in the SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position I player of the receiving team for set 2.*

Set 1 begins at 3:13 p.m. *Fill in the START block with 15:13 p.m.*

Orange #9 serves the ball and wins a point. #9 serves two more points then serves the ball out of bounds. *You may begin using pencil starting now. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange #9, slash points 1, 2, & 3 in the POINTS column of the Orange team, write the exit score of 3, slash point 1 in the POINTS column of the Purple team.*

Purple #18 serves one point and then serves the ball into the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Purple #18, slash point 2 in the POINTS column of the PURPLE team, write the exit score of 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for #18, slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Orange team.*

Orange #15 has the ball, the referee beckons for serve but #15 stalls. The ref counts to 8, blows her whistle and signals a sideout. *#15 did not serve the ball so record an exit score of 4 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box, but DO NOT tick the 1. Slash point 3 in the POINTS column of the Purple team.*

Purple's coach calls for a substitution and subs #2 for #13. After serving three points, Orange Reserve Libero #21 replaces Acting Libero #1. Purple #2 serves two more points before siding out. Orange #5 re-enters the lineup, replacing Libero #21. *Slash the number 13 in the box in Purple's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 2 to the immediate right of the slashed number 13. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position III, record the score with Purple's score listed first (3/4). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Purple #2, slash points 4, 5, & 6. The Assistant Scorer marks the Libero changes for the Orange team. Slash points 7 & 8 in the POINTS column of the Purple team, write the exit score of 8, and slash point 5 in the POINTS column of the Orange team. Assistant Scorer records #5 re-entering the match for Libero.*

Orange #22 is serving. She scores two points; Purple #7 then replaces Acting Libero #17. She scores two more points before the Purple coach requests a time-out. The referee whistles for teams to return to the court after the time-out, but Purple remains in their huddle. The R1 tweets again giving Purple a Verbal Warning. After play resumes Orange #22 serves the ball in the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange 22, slash points 6 & 7. Libero changes are marked by assistant scorer. Slash points 8 & 9. Record the time-out in Purple's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column, listing Purple's cumulative score first followed by Orange's cumulative score (recorded 8:9). Nothing is recorded for the Verbal Warning. Write an exit score of 9 for Orange #22 and slash point 9 in the POINTS column of the Purple team.*

Purple #6 serves three points. Orange coach sends a sub into the substitution zone, #11 for #3c. The second referee asks Orange coach for a new captain and 15 is chosen. Purple #6 serves two more points and then they lose the rally. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Purple #6. Slash points 10, 11, & 12. Slash the number 3c in the box of Orange's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 11 to the immediate right of the slashed number 3c. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V (still on Orange's side of the score sheet), record the score with Orange's*

score listed first (9/12). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section, is slashed. Place a small 'c' next to number 15 in Orange's N OF PLAYERS column to signal a new captain. Slash points 13 & 14 in the POINTS column of the Purple team, write the exit score of 14, and slash point 10 in the POINTS column of the Orange team.

Orange #19 serves an ace then serves the ball out. Their coach requests a time-out. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange #19. Slash point 11 then write the exit score for #19. Slash point 15 in the POINTS column of the Purple team. Record the time-out in Orange's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column, first listing Orange's cumulative score followed by Purple's cumulative score (recorded 11:15).

#17, the Acting Libero for Purple goes back to serve for #4. The team wins the next two rallies then hits the ball out. After serving, the Acting Libero is replaced by the Reserve Libero, #3. Since the Libero is serving for #4 you place a triangle over the Roman numeral for Player Position V. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Purple #4/Libero. Triangles are placed around each point earned during the service round, so 16 & 17 will be inside the triangle. An exit score of 17 is recorded and point 12 is slashed in the Orange POINTS column.

Orange 11 serves and Purple returns the ball and it lands on the back line. The line judge signals out but the R1 over rules the call and rewards Purple with the point. The coach for Orange stands up arguing the call and the R2 gestures for him to stop and sit back down. He continues to yell and argue, so the R1 issues a Yellow Card. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange #11. Write the exit score of 12 and slash point 18 in the POINTS column of the Purple team. The Yellow Card is recorded in the SANCTIONS BOX at the bottom of the score sheet. Place a 'C' for coach in the first row underneath the PENALTY column. Also in that row record Team B for Orange, set 1, and score at the time of penalty was 12:18 (list Orange's cumulative score first followed by Purple's cumulative score). After recording the sanction slash and circle point 19 in Purple's POINTS column. This will represent the penalty point.

Purple #20 enters the substitution zone and subs in for #33. Purple #20 serves the ball out. The coach requests another sub and replaces #20 with #1. Slash the number 33 in the box in Purple's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 20 to the immediate right of the slashed number 33. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position VI, record the score with Purple's score listed first (19/12). Team SUBSTITUTION 2, under the scoring section, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Purple #20, write the exit score of 19, and slash point 13 in Orange's POINTS column. Now slash number 20 in Purple's N OF PLAYERS row, substitute number 1 to the immediate right or underneath the slashed 20. In the second box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position VI, record the score (19/13). Slash the 3 in Team SUBSTITUTIONS under the scoring section.

Orange coach subs #3c back in for #11. Orange #5 goes back to serve and the team wins three points before a sideout. Slash the number 11 in the box of Orange's N OF PLAYERS row and write the substitute number 3c to the immediate right. In the second box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V, record the score with Orange's score listed first (13/19). Slash the 2 in Team SUBSTITUTIONS. Since #3 is back in the game, she resumes the role as captain, slash through the 'c' next to player 15. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange #5, slash points 14, 15, & 16, write the exit score of 16, slash point 20 in the POINTS column of the Purple team.

Purple #7 serves the ball out. Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box below the 'X' for Purple #7, write the exit score of 20, slash point 17 in the POINTS column of the Orange team.

Orange #9 rotates to serve the ball. The team wins 4 rallies before Purple coach calls for time-out. Once again the team remains in huddle after the time-out is over. The first referee issues a Team Delay Penalty. Orange #9 serves again and they lose the rally. Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box (directly below box 1) for Orange #9. Slash points 18, 19, 20 & 21. Record the time-out in Purple's bottom TIME-OUTS box, directly beneath the score of Purple's first time-out (recorded 20:21). In the SANCTIONS BOX, second row of the PENALTY column record a 'D'. In the same row record team at fault (A), set 1, and score at time of Penalty (20:21). Orange receives a penalty point. Slash and circle point 22, write the exit score of 22, and slash point 21 for Purple.

Orange Acting Libero #1 enters for #9; Purple #7 replaces the Acting Libero. Purple's captain serves an ace. Purple wins the next two rallies on kills, then #18 serves into the net. Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box (directly below box 1) for Purple #18. Slash points 22, 23 & 24, write the exit score of 24, slash point 23 for Orange.

Orange #15 serves, and the teams rally until Purple #6 earns a kill. Purple now has 25 points and the set is over. *Tick the 2 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Orange #15. Write the exit score of 23, slash point 25 for Purple. In the second box in the SERVICE ROUNDS section for Purple #2 write a 25, DO NOT tick this box.*

The time is 3:44. *Put down the pencil and use ink to complete the scoresheet. Record in all caps the WINNING TEAM and score and LOSING TEAM and score in the RESULTS box for SET 1 (Purple 25 Orange 23). Put the time, 15:44, in the END box for set 1. Hourglass the unused points in the POINTS column for each team. Circle the last SERVICE ROUNDS boxes (exit scores) for each team. Check the scoresheet over. Since we used the scoresheet with sets 1 & 2 on the same page, you do not sign until the end of set 2. For Gateway competition the R1 and team captain signatures are not required.*

Explanation of Scorekeeping Example

Deciding Set

The recording of events in a deciding set is exactly the same as a non-deciding set with the exception of a court change. A deciding set score sheet is used. Information for the team starting on the left court is placed on the left side of the score sheet and continues on the right side of the score sheet when the teams change courts at eight points.

The scorekeeper records most information on both sides of the score sheet before the set and as the set progresses. This includes the starting lineups, substitutions, and time outs. The information in the **Service Rounds** and **Points** section is **not** repeated on the right side of the score sheet.

During the court change the scorekeeper verifies that the required information from the far left is repeated on the far right (substitutions are repeated in the **N of Players** column, substitution scores are repeated in the **Score at time of Substitution** section, **Substitution** numbers are slashed, and time out scores are recorded). The scorekeeper should take particular note that the team references are now reversed.

When a team has reached 8 points, the scorekeeper records the points scored by the team on the far left in the circle labeled **Points at Chg.**

*Team on the left serves for point 8: check mark in **Service Rounds** box on far left, **X** in **Service Rounds** box on far right; no score recorded in Service Rounds box on far left; final exit score recorded in **Service Rounds** box on far right.

*Team on left earns point 8 on a side out or team on right earns point 8: no check mark in **Service Rounds** box on far left, repeat last exit score from previous server using an **X** instead of a check mark. When the next server serves the ball enter a check mark in the **Service Rounds** box on far right; final exit score is recorded in Service Rounds box on far right.

The tournament is the 2012 Volley Fest in St. Louis, MO. The match is being played at Lincoln Middle School on court 7. This is pool D, match number 8 for junior girls at the 14's level. The date is March 19, 2012, and the match is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. This is set 3 in the match with Green playing Pink. Fred Bread is the 1st referee, Clare Flare is the 2nd referee, you are the scorekeeper, and Yellow from the Gateway Region is your work team. *The scorekeeper records all heading information using CAPITAL LETTERS and ink. Time is recorded in International time (HH:MM).*

Green won the coin toss and chose to serve. Pink will receive from the court to the right of the scorekeeper. The lineup for Green is 6c, 2, 9, 12, 20, 4 & 11 as the libero. The lineup for Pink is 1, 7c, 10, 8, 3, 15 & 19 as the libero. *The scorekeeper enters the team names (all CAPS and in ink) and player numbers on the appropriate sides of the score sheet for set 3. Green is on the far left and far right of the score sheet with Pink in the middle. Fill in the appropriate circles designating Team A & B (3 total). For our purposes Green will be Team A, Pink will be Team B. The scorekeeper then places an X over the encircled S and R for the respective teams, and places an X in SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position 1 player of the receiving team. In a deciding set the information of the team starting on the far left is also recorded on the far right of the score sheet.*

Set 3 begins at 9:37 a.m. *Fill in the START block with 09:37 a.m.*

Green #6 serves and wins a point. The team rallies and wins one more point then loses the serve. *You may begin using pencil starting now. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #6 on the left side of the sheet. Slash points 1 & 2 in the POINTS column of the GREEN team on the LEFT side ONLY. Write the exit score of 2. Slash point 1 in the POINTS column of the PINK team.*

Pink captain serves two points and then serves the ball into the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #7, slash points 2 & 3 in the POINTS column of the PINK team. Write the exit score of 3 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for #7, slash point 3 in the POINTS column on the left for the Green team.*

Green #2 serves the ball out. *Tick the 1 and write an exit score of 3 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the left. Slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink #10 serves an ace. They win another point then lose the serve. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #10, slash points 5 & 6 in the POINTS column of the Pink team, write the exit score of 6, slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Green team.*

Green coach calls for a sub and #5 replaces #9. #5 scores a point before losing the ball on a block by Pink. *Slash the number 9 and write the substitute number 5 to the immediate right of the slashed 9 in the box of Green's N OF PLAYERS row on the left AND far right side of the score sheet. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V (also on both sides of the score sheet), record the score with Green's score listed first (4/6). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section on each side, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the left side for Green #5, slash point 5. Write an exit score of 5 and slash point 7 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink #8 serves and scores a point. Pink now has 8 points so the teams will change sides. Players stay on the court and play immediately continues. #8 serves two more points before Green calls a time-out. After the time-out Green wins the ball. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #8 and slash point 8. Since the teams switch sides you are done recording on the far left side of the score sheet. Write a 5 in the PTS AT CHG circle on the far right side (above Green's POINTS column). Place a little 'X' over the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #5 and record the last exit score of 5. Slash points 9 & 10 in the POINTS column of the Pink team. Record the time-out in Green's top TIME OUTS box located on the right side under the running score column, first listing Green's cumulative score followed by Pink's cumulative score (recorded 5:10). Write the exit score of 10 in Pink #8's SERVICE ROUNDS box, and slash point 6 in the POINTS column of the Green team. Point 6 should be the first point slashed in the running score column for Green on the far right side of the score sheet.*

Green #12 is serving. Her team wins three rallies then 12 serves the ball into the net. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the far right for Green #12. Slash points 7, 8, & 9 then write the exit score of 9 for #12. Slash point 11 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

#3 for Pink is subbed out for #18. The team wins the next two rallies then hits the ball out. *Slash the number 3 and write the substitute number 18 to the immediate right in the box of Pink's N OF PLAYERS row. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V record the score with Pink's score listed first (11/9). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #18. Slash points 12 & 13. The exit score is recorded and point 10 is slashed in the Green POINTS column.*

Green 20 serves an ace followed by another point. Pink coach calls for a time-out. After the time-out Green wins another rally then sides-out. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #20. Slash points 11 & 12 in the Green POINTS column. Record the time-out in Pink's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column. List Pink's cumulative score followed by Green's cumulative score (recorded 13:12). Slash point 13 in Green's POINTS column and write the exit score of 13. Slash point 14 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink #15 serves, her team wins the point and ends the match. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #15, slash point 15 in the POINTS column and write the exit score of 15.*

The time is 9:54. *Put down the pencil and use ink to complete the score sheet. Record in all caps the WINNING TEAM and score and LOSING TEAM and score in the RESULTS box for SET 3 (Pink 15 Green 13). Put the time, 09:54, in the END box for set 3. Circle the final exit scores (in the last SERVICE ROUNDS box) for each team. Hourglass the unused points in the POINTS column on the right side for each team. Check the score sheet over and then sign your name. For Gateway competition the R1 and team captain signatures are not required.*

Explanation of Scorekeeping Example

Deciding Set with Libero serving

The tournament is the 2012 Volley Fest in St. Louis, MO. The match is being played at Lincoln Middle School on court 7. This is pool D, match number 8 for junior girls at the 14's level. The date is March 19, 2012, and the match is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. This is set 3 in the match with Green playing Pink. Fred Bread is the 1st referee, Clare Flare is the 2nd referee, you are the scorekeeper, and Yellow from the Gateway Region is your work team. *The scorekeeper records all heading information using CAPITAL LETTERS and ink. Time is recorded in International time (HH:MM).*

Green won the coin toss and chose to serve. Pink will receive from the court to the right of the scorekeeper. The lineup for Green is 6c, 2, 9, 12, 20, & 4. The Acting Libero (L) is 11 and the Reserve Libero (R) is 13. The lineup for Pink is 1, 7c, 10, 8, 3, 15 & 19 as the Libero. After the line-up check, Green Acting Libero #11 enters for #20 and Pink Libero #19 replaces #15. *The scorekeeper enters the team names (all CAPS and in ink) and player numbers on the appropriate sides of the score sheet for set 3. Green is on the far left and far right of the score sheet with Pink in the middle. Fill in the appropriate circles designating Team A & B (3 total). For our purposes Green will be Team A, Pink will be Team B. The scorekeeper then places an X over the encircled S and R for the respective teams, and places an X in SERVICE ROUNDS box 1 for the Position I player of the receiving team. In a deciding set the information of the team starting on the far left is also recorded on the far right of the score sheet.*

Set 3 begins at 9:37 a.m. *Fill in the START block with 09:37 a.m.*

Green #6 serves and wins a point. The team rallies and wins one more point then loses the serve. *You may begin using pencil starting now. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #6 on the left side of the sheet. Slash points 1 & 2 in the POINTS column of the GREEN team on the LEFT side ONLY. Write the exit score of 2. Slash point 1 in the POINTS column of the PINK team.*

Pink captain serves two points and then serves the ball into the net. #20 Green replaces Acting Libero #11; Green Reserve Libero #13 replaces #6, and #2 is the new captain. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #7; slash points 2 & 3 in the POINTS column of the PINK team. Write the exit score of 3 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for #7; slash point 3 in the POINTS column on the left for the Green team. Record Libero changes on the Libero Tracking Sheet. Slash the 'c' next to #6 and mark it next to #2 for the Green team.*

Green #2 serves the ball out. *Tick the 1 and write an exit score of 3 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the left. Slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink #15 re-enters, and Libero #19 goes to serve. They win another point then lose the serve. *Since the Libero is serving for #10 you place a triangle over the Roman numeral for Player Position III. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #10/Libero. Triangles are placed around each point earned during the service round, so 5 & 6 will be inside the triangle in the POINTS column of the Pink team. Write the exit score of 6, slash point 4 in the POINTS column of the Green team.*

Green coach calls for a sub and #5 replaces #9. #5 scores a point before losing the ball on a block by Pink. *Slash the number 9 and write the substitute number 5 to the immediate right of the slashed 9 in the box of Green's N OF PLAYERS row on the left AND far right side of the score sheet. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V (also on both sides of the score sheet), record the score with Green's score listed first (4/6). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section on each side, is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the left side for Green #5, slash point 5. Write an exit score of 5 and slash point 7 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink #8 serves and scores a point. Pink now has 8 points so the teams will change sides. Players stay on the court and play immediately continues. #8 serves two more points before Green calls a time-out. After the time-out Green wins the ball. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #8 and slash point 8. Since the teams switch sides you are done recording on the far left side of the score sheet. Write a 5 in the PTS AT CHG circle on the far right side (above Green's POINTS column). Place a little 'X' over the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #5 and record the last exit score of*

5. Slash points 9 & 10 in the POINTS column of the Pink team. Record the time-out in Green's top TIME OUTS box located on the right side under the running score column, first listing Green's cumulative score followed by Pink's cumulative score (recorded 5:10). Write the exit score of 10 in Pink #8's SERVICE ROUNDS box, and slash point 6 in the POINTS column of the Green team. Point 6 should be the first point slashed in the running score column for Green on the far right side of the score sheet.

Before Green #12 serves, Green Reserve Libero #13 rotates to the front row. She is replaced by #6, who is re-designated as the captain. Green team wins three rallies then 12 serves the ball into the net. *The Assistant Scorer marks the changes on the Libero Tracking Sheet. You slash the 'c' next to #2 and record a new 'c' by #6. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box on the far right for Green #12. Slash points 7, 8, & 9 then write the exit score of 9 for #12. Slash point 11 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

#3 for Pink is subbed out for #18. The team wins the next two rallies then hits the ball out. *Slash the number 3 and write the substitute number 18 to the immediate right in the box of Pink's N OF PLAYERS row. In the first box in the SCORE AT CHANGE section for Position V record the score with Pink's score listed first (11/9). Team SUBSTITUTION 1, under the scoring section is slashed. Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #18. Slash points 12 & 13. The exit score is recorded and point 10 is slashed in the Green POINTS column.*

Green 20 serves an ace followed by another point. Pink coach calls for a time-out. After the time-out Green wins another rally then sides-out. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Green #20. Slash points 11 & 12 in the Green POINTS column. Record the time-out in Pink's top TIME OUTS box located under the running score column. List Pink's cumulative score followed by Green's cumulative score (recorded 13:12). Slash point 13 in Green's POINTS column and write the exit score of 13. Slash point 14 in the POINTS column of the Pink team.*

Pink Libero #19 rotates to the front row, where she is replaced by #10. Pink #15 serves, her team wins the point and ends the match. *Tick the 1 in the SERVICE ROUNDS box for Pink #15, slash point 15 in the POINTS column and write the exit score of 15.*

The time is 9:54. *Put down the pencil and use ink to complete the score sheet. Record in all caps the WINNING TEAM and score and LOSING TEAM and score in the RESULTS box for SET 3 (Pink 15 Green 13). Put the time, 09:54, in the END box for set 3. Circle the final exit scores (in the last SERVICE ROUNDS box) for each team. Hourglass the unused points in the POINTS column on the right side for each team. Check the score sheet over and then sign your name. For Gateway competition the R1 and team captain signatures are not required.*
